I am requesting funding for the Village of Manhattan Wastewater Treatment Plant Expansion in Fiscal Year 2027. The funding would be used to fund the construction costs associated with expanding the capacity of the Village wastewater treatment plant, which currently operates at 98.5% of its design capacity.
