Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the South Side Red Line Stations State of Good Repair Improvements Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding is the Chicago Transit Authority, located at 567 W Lake St Chicago, IL 60661. The funding will be used to keep several CTA Red Line stations in a state of good repair. Specifically, Red Line Stations at 63rd, 69th and 79th, will replace all exterior station doors ensuring riders are safe from the elements, while the 35th/Sox Red Line Station will receive station and canopy improvements to address water intrusion and necessary pigeon abatement upgrades. The project is a good use of federal funds because it will bring multiple public transit stations into states of good repair, improving the quality of services for over 3.75 million annual riders.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 23 USC 133.
